



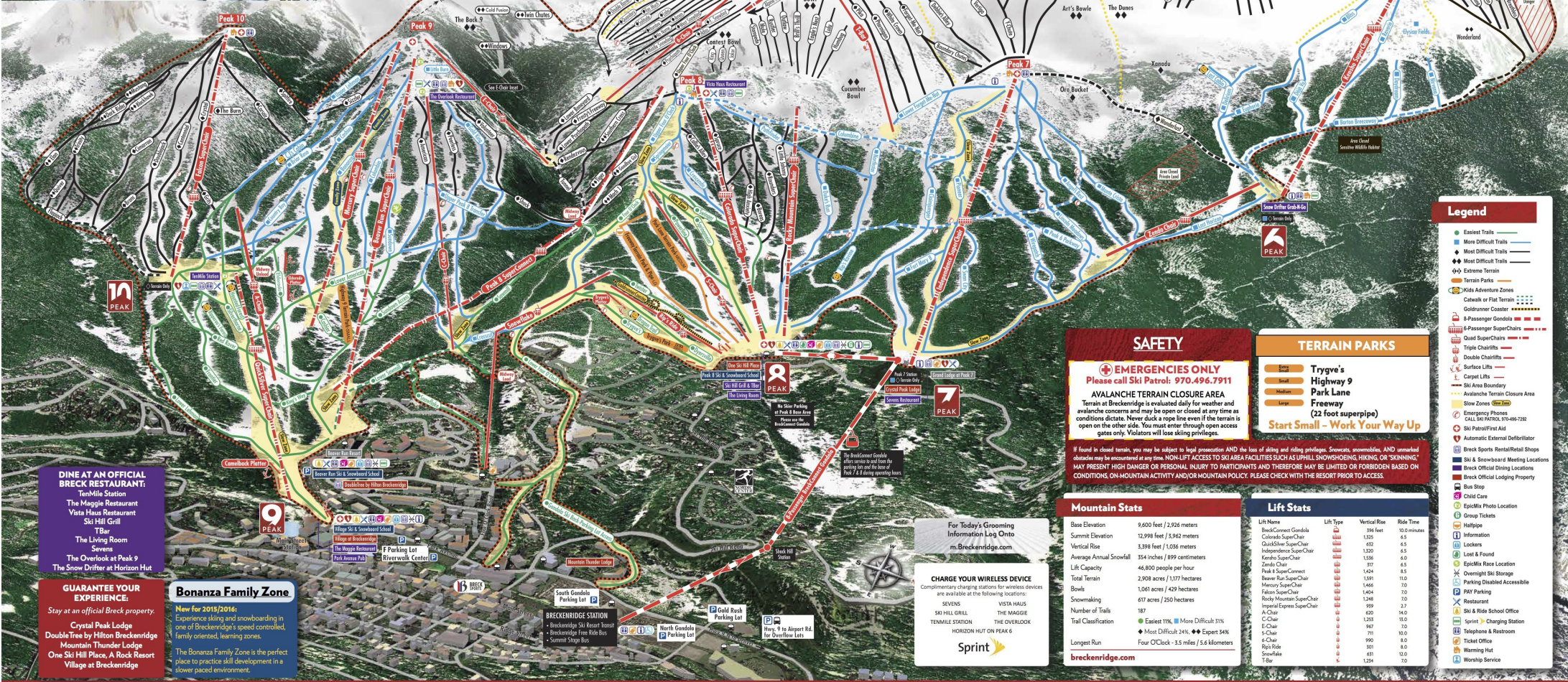

AVALANCHE TERRAIN CLOSURE AREA
 Terrain at Breckenridge is evaluated daily for weather and avalanche concerns and may be open or closed at any time as conditions dictate. Never duck a rope line even if the terrain is open on the other side. You must enter through open access gates only. Violators will lose skiing privileges.

If found in closed terrain, you may be subject to legal prosecution AND the loss of lifting and riding privileges. Snowcats, snowmobiles, AND unmarked outcades may be encountered at any time. NON-LIFT ACCESS TO SKI AREA FACILITIES SUCH AS UPHILL SNOWSHOING, HIKING, OR "SKINNING" MAY PRESENT HIGH DANGER OR PERSONAL INJURY TO PARTICIPANTS AND THEREFORE MAY BE LIMITED OR FORBIDDEN BASED ON CONDITIONS ON MOUNTAIN ACTIVITY AND/OR MOUNTAIN POLICY. PLEASE CHECK WITH THE RESORT PRIOR TO ACCESS.
